1st Quarter Directors Meeting – March 23, 2019

The 2019 1st Quarter Board of Directors meeting for the Kansas Chapter 3 International Harvester Collectors Club was held at the Central Kansas Flywheel Club grounds in Salina, KS. President Larry Carr called the meeting to order at 11:15 a.m. with the following Directors present Carr/B. Connelly/K. Secretary's Report: The 4th Quarter Directors meeting minutes were approved with no additions or changes.

TREASURERS REPORT:

Janice Meyer reported a treasury balance of \$7446.10 as of March 23, 2019. Treasurers Report was approved as presented. Treasurers bond has been renewed. The annual IRS Form 990N for non-profit organizations has been filed for Chapter 3.

MEMBERSHIP REPORT:

Janice Meyer reported Chapter 3 membership at 194 as of March 23, 2019. Five new members and three rejoin members. Two sympathy cards sent to families of members who passed, Ken Houck, 3/20/18 and Alvin Friesen, 4/1/2018. Dues renewal is progressing well. March 31st is the deadline for renewals. Anyone not paid by then will be dropped.

OLD BUSINESS:

Museum Committee: President Carr update the board on recent letter received from National Legal Counsel, Dick Forster regarding the Stuckey's property near Lindsborg. Due to the potential liability risks inherent with former gas stations having ground and/or water contamination from leaking petroleum tanks, the National Board would not approve a purchase of said property as a Museum site. The National board is not opposed to Chapter 3 having a museum but the site needs to not have liability risks associated with it.

Fundraiser Tractor: The Super A fundraiser tractor will be at the upcoming Salina and Great Bend farm shows.

**1937 F-20 International Tractor • Serial #FA 99225
Jordan Burghart - Tecumseh, Kansas**

This F-20 tractor was purchased from the Kraft International Dealership in Stull, Kansas on August 1, 1938 by Lincoln J. Eller.

It was the first rubber tire tractor sold at the Kraft International Dealership. The tractor was delivered on August 2, 1938. It was immediately connected to a thrashing machine and put to work on the neighboring farm of Clyde Anno.

In 1942 Lincoln Eller had the Kraft International Dealership install a deluxe seat, deluxe steering wheel, foot brakes, overdrive, electric starter, and head lights. Alfred Rake performed the installation.

Lincoln Eller sold the tractor to Ed Harrop in 1957.

Lincoln Eller gave Jake Elliott the owner's manual to the tractor in 1989. They decided to drive over to the farm of Ed Harrop and see if he still had the F-20. When Ed showed Lincoln the tractor, tears came to Lincoln's eyes. This F-20 was the first brand new tractor that Lincoln had ever purchased.

Lincoln Eller passed away September 15, 1989. Jake Elliott then purchased the 48 acre farm. In a box of papers in the upstairs bedroom of the farmhouse, Jake found the original purchase agreement between the Kraft International Dealership and Lincoln Eller. Jake purchased Lincoln's F-20 from Ed Harrop in 1992 when Ed moved to Arizona. Jake drove the tractor back to the Eller Farm and parked it in the shed from which it started in 1938.

Jake pulled the F-20 from that shed on January 6, 2007 after 14 years of storage to show before restoration. Kenneth "Jake" Elliott passed away October 20, 2017 before restoration could be completed.

On March 10, 2018 Jordan Burghart purchased the F-20 at the farm sale that was conducted. On April 17, 2018 the Burghart family purchased 16 acres including the former homestead where Lincoln Eller resided.

Restoration on the F-20 was completed July 2018 with the help of Preston Lutz.
